2. DIGILOCKER & ABC ID for Students

As per Government of Uttarakhand directives (Letter No. 13/NAD-A.B.C./2023-24), from this academic year, it will be mandatory for all students to open an Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) account at <http://www.abc.gov.in>. The Academic Bank of Credit referred to as ABC in short, is a virtual mechanism that will deal with the credits earned by students of Higher Education Institutes in India and which are recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC).

How to get an ABC ID?

Before creating ABC ID student must have **Adhaar-Mobile number linked**.

1. Login to DigiLocker (Download from Google Playstore). Student with DigiLocker Account can create ABC ID.
2. Search for Education. Education category shows Academic Bank of Credits service.
3. Create ABC ID. Select your University and click on Generate ABC ID.
4. Accumulate Credits. Students can check accumulated credits by logging into abc.gov.in.
